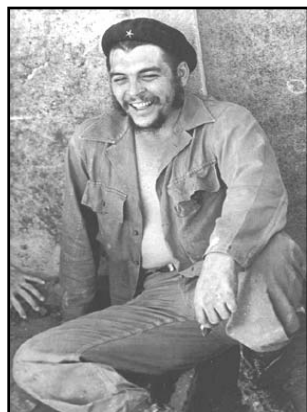
The Greening of Cuba

Challenged with growing food for 11 million in the face of the continuing U.S. blockade, Cuba embarked on the largest conversion to organic farming ever attempted in the 1990s. Told in the voices of the women and men who are leading the organic agriculture movement, "The Greening of Cuba" reminds us that developed and developing nations alike can choose a healthier environment and still feed their people.
