After a nearly two month-long occupation of Zócalo - the square in the center of Mexico City that's famous for mass rallies by the people - millions of Mexico's poor participated in a National Democratic Convention and have embraced the call for a parallel government. Felipe Calderón - the candidate favored by the United States - has been declared the winner, activists have vowed to disrupt him whenever he speaks, in the same way that they prevented outgoing president Vicente Fox from delivering his final state of the union address. Coming so soon after the mass uprising of mostly Mexican immigrant workers in the United States, this reawakening of the powerful people's movement in Mexico itself clearly has the U.S. ruling class concerned.
