DAMAGED PROPERTY: The west front door has a stain glass / decorative window built into the center of the door. The window was punched out of the door along the bottom and sides of the window. The Witnesses estimated the damage at about \$600.00 or more.

Total Damage: \$600.00

NARRATIVE:

At about 0156 hours, 5-22-08, Officer Coley, Officer Sanchez, and I responded to 13940 Sandstone for an unknown type of disturbance. The residents at that address had called 911 and left the telephone off the hook. Dispatch advised over the radio that a disturbance could be heard over the telephone.

When we arrived, we approached the front door. I saw the decorative window to the west front door had been broken. There was glass on the front door step. I saw a seashell against the front door. There was a half full Pierre bottle standing next to the east front door. I also saw a cellular telephone on the front step, about two feet from the front door. [REDACTED]. They told me that an unknown Hispanic male had been shouting at the front door. The subject broke the window and fled. The Suspect was described as wearing no shirt and having a thin build. I broadcasted this information over the radio. Officer Coley and Officer Sanchez searched the outside of the residence and then began searching the area in their Units. Both Witnesses said they had not seen the cellular phone or Pierre bottle before. The seashell belonged on a planter near the front step.

Injuries: Refer to Officer Manjarrez report.

Narrative: On 5-22-08 at about 0214 hrs. I was on patrol in a clearly marked police vehicle. I was driving E/B Los Angeles St. approaching Baldwin Park Blvd.

I saw a vehicle, lic. Plate # 5JZR064 quickly turn onto W/B Los Angeles from N/B Baldwin Park Blvd. I could see the vehicle was traveling quickly and I could hear the tires breaking traction from the roadway. The driver almost lost control of the vehicle in the turn. (violation of 22350 VC) The vehicle was also traveling without lighted headlamps. (violation of 24400 VC) I made a u-turn and activated my overhead red lamp. The vehicle immediately came to a stop in the #1 W/B lane of traffic.

The driver/sole occupant, later identified as S. Corona, was yelling incoherently but I could not understand what he was saying. He quickly exited the car and started walking back to me. Corona was not wearing a shirt and was sweating profusely.

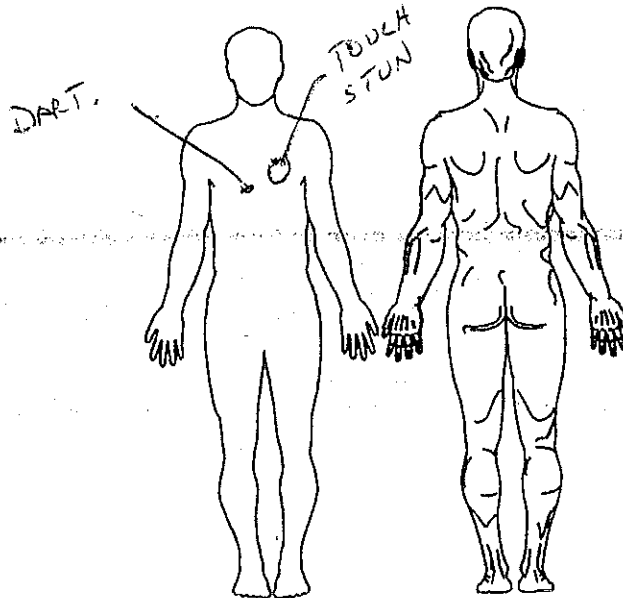
Corona was smiling and yelling, "Just kill me, I want to live, I'm alive." Corona was flailing his arms wildly. I believed Corona was going to attack me. I drew my department issued Taser and told Corona three times to stop. He refused to comply and kept advancing. When I pointed my Taser at Corona he stopped his advance and started to quickly walk backwards and to the south, as if he was trying to now escape. I deployed the Taser one cycle striking Corona in the chest. Corona stumbled backwards but did not fall. He then continued to quickly walk south. I grabbed Coronas left wrist with my right hand. I followed up with a second Taser activation by touching it to Coronas chest and pushing him to the ground. The second Taser activation was successful and I was able to push Corona's face down on the street.

Officers Valdivia and Manjarrez took over the investigation. Refer to their reports.

On 05-22-08, at approximately 0214hours, Officer Valdivia #2823 and I assisted Sergeant Parnell #2208 on a traffic stop at Los Angeles Street and La Rica Avenue. Upon arrival, I saw Sergeant Parnell's police unit stopped in the number one lane of westbound Los Angeles Street with his unit rotating lights on. I saw grey Volkswagen stopped in front of Sergeant Parnell's police unit with its front headlights off. Officer Valdivia and I stopped and exited our police unit and I then saw the male subject waving his arms at Sergeant Parnell. I ran towards Sergeant Parnell to assist him and saw Sergeant Parnell use his department issued taser and deploy it at the male subject who was combative with Sergeant Parnell. I then saw the male subject fall to the ground and I assisted him in handcuffing the subject. The subject was later identified as Corona by his expired California driver's license.

As I observed Corona, he appeared nervous as if someone was chasing him. Corona could not stop moving, Corona made numerous attempts in trying to stand on his feet while he was lying on his stomach handcuffed and he was sweating profusely on a cool night. I noticed that Corona's lips were dry and he kept asking me if I could give him water because he was thirsty. I also noticed that Corona's jaw moved from side to side and at times he would grind his teeth. Through patrol experience and training, I recognize these symptoms to be associated with a person who is under the influence of a controlled substance (Stimulant).

For my safety, I patted down S-Corona. While I was patting him down, I again noticed he shook uncontrollably and he kept licking his lips. I again recognized these symptoms to be associated with the use of a controlled substance (Stimulant). [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Believing S-Corona was under the influence of a controlled substance, I took his pulse from his right wrist, at 0225 hours. I used my wristwatch to time his pulse, and found it was 130 beats per minute. During my investigation, I attempted to conduct a Rhomberg stand test, but Corona would not stand still and kept moving his body back and forth and from side to side. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] During my investigation, I applied direct light to both of Corona's eyes and noticed that his pupils were dilated to 6.5 on both eyes under direct light. Through patrol experience and training, I know that a normal person's pupils should be between 2.5 to 3.5 under direct light stimulus. I asked Corona to close his eyes and I noticed he had eyelid tremors. At 0230 hours, I again took Corona's pulse and I found it to be at 140 beats per minute. [REDACTED]

During my investigation in the field, Officer Wilson informed me that the subject we had detained might possibly be the same subject related to his vandalism investigation (refer to Officer Wilson's vandalism report). During a field show up, the victim of the vandalism told Officer Wilson that the subject we had detained might be the subject that vandalized their residence. The victim also told Officer Wilson that they knew the subject as Sergio Corona. [REDACTED]

Due to my observations, S-Corona's objective symptoms of driving a motor vehicle under the influence of a controlled substance, and him telling me that he smoked methamphetamine and marijuana earlier in the night, I formed the opinion S-Corona was under the influence of a controlled substance (central nervous system stimulant). I arrested Corona for 11550 H&S, under the influence of a controlled substance (Stimulant), 23152(a) V.C. D.U.I., 594(b)(1) P.C. felony vandalism.

Before transporting Corona to BPPD for booking, I transported him to Kaiser Permanente Hospital for medical treatment. While at the hospital, DR. Vutpadi treated Corona for his injuries. While at the hospital, Corona was yelling and would not stand still. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] For precautionary reasons by the hospital, Corona was placed on a gurney in soft restraints. While treating Corona, DR. Vutpadi told me that Corona showed symptoms of being under the influence of controlled

During my investigation, Corona's vehicle was stored at Royal Coaches towing (Refer to the CHP-180 form).

Narrative:
