Together, we will produce the first independently published magazine that explores the Filipino-American experience.

We the coming of our inaugural first issue in **mid-August**, TAYO Literary Magazine will reach the Filipino American community in many different media outlets. We are celebrating and distributing our magazine in mid-August with the TAYO Launch Party, with 150-175 people in attendance. We are also distributing our magazine at the *8th Annual Filipino American Library Gala and Spirit Awards*, with 350-400 in attendence. We are distributing our magazine during the *18th Annual Festival of Philippine Arts & Culture* put on by FilAm Arts, with 25,000 people in attendance. In addition, we are distributing our magazine online via our website, which receives 1,000 hits weekly. By partnering with **BakitWhy.com**, during their *One Year Anniversary Party* we are also distributing TAYO preview magazines in their VIP schwag bags, which will be given to many prominent Filipino Americans and celebrities, ranging from Allan Pineda better known as **apl.de.ap**, Christine Gambito as **HappySlip**, and Jannelle So from **Kababayan LA**, Channel 18.
