

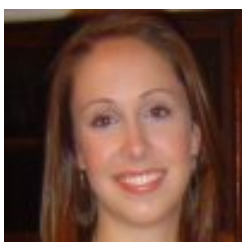


The War on Women and What It Has To Do With the Separation of Church and State

He had become a Jehovah's Witness and could no longer in good conscience support any procedure that might involve a blood transfusion.
