Yuval Ron is an internationally renowned World Music artist, composer, educator, peace activist and record producer. Graduating Cum Laude as a Film Scoring Major at Berklee College of Music in Boston, he has continuously researched various ethnic

musical traditions and spiritual paths worldwide. Among his many honors, he composed the songs and score for the Oscar winning film West Bank Story in 2007, was the featured artist in the Gala Concert for the Dalai Lama's initiative Seeds of Compassion in the Seattle Opera Hall in 2008, and received commissions from the Getty Center, Los Angeles International Airport, Japan-America Theater, American Repertory Ballet and more. His awards include the Los Angeles Treasures Award in 2004 and prestigious grants from the National Endowment for the Arts, American Composers Forum, California Council for the Humanities and the Rockefeller Foundation. His is an author of the book Divine Attunement: Music as a Path to Wisdom published by Oracle Institute Press.

Master artist *Radha Prasad* was born and raised in Northern India, where he first taught himself to play the flute as a child. After hearing the music of Pandit Hariprasad Chaurasia, India's most skilled flutist, he moved to Bombay and began 18 years of



The training provided him with broad knowledge of Indian classical and folk music and he received a Master of Arts in Music from Pandit Chaurasia's school, the Vrindaban Flute Institute. Prasad has toured India, the United States and Europe with his renowned teacher. Since moving to Los Angeles, he opened his own school, teaching Indian classical instrumental and vocal music.
