California Democrats to Select Delegates to State Convention

FOUNTAIN VALLEY, CA (December 16, 2006) – A bi-annual election of delegates to the California Democratic Convention from the 68th Assembly District will take place on Sunday, January 14th, at 2:00 pm in Fountain Valley. Approximately 1/3 of all delegates to the Democratic State Convention will be elected from residents in each of the 80 Assembly Districts in California.

Delegates serve a term of two years including the 2007 and 2008 Democratic State Conventions. Delegates are responsible for all costs of travel and fees to attend these conventions.

The election of twelve delegates from the 68th Assembly District will take place at the Green Valley Association Club House located at 17250 Los Jardines West in Fountain Valley. From among these delegates one person will also be elected to represent the Assembly District on the State Executive Board.

All Democrats registered as of the November 7, 2006 election are encouraged to attend and vote for delegates who will represent their vision of the party. The Democratic Party encourages members of the party to participate at all levels of party leadership and to contribute to a strong, volunteer activist organization that will strengthen the Democratic Party in California to serve the needs of all Californians. There will be a \$5 registration fee to defer costs.
