Help is needed with set-up and altar-building - arrive at or soon after 6 p.m. to help. This ritual is "clean and sober", i.e. no recreational drugs or alcohol.

Brigid's season marks the end of winter and portents the spring. Brigid was the mighty Celtic Triple Goddess of inspiration, art & poetry, healing, childbirth and smithcraft. The festival of Brigid (also known as Candlemas, Lady Day or Imbolc) is the time of year to replenish your creative wells and make a commitment or recommitment to your spiritual growth.
