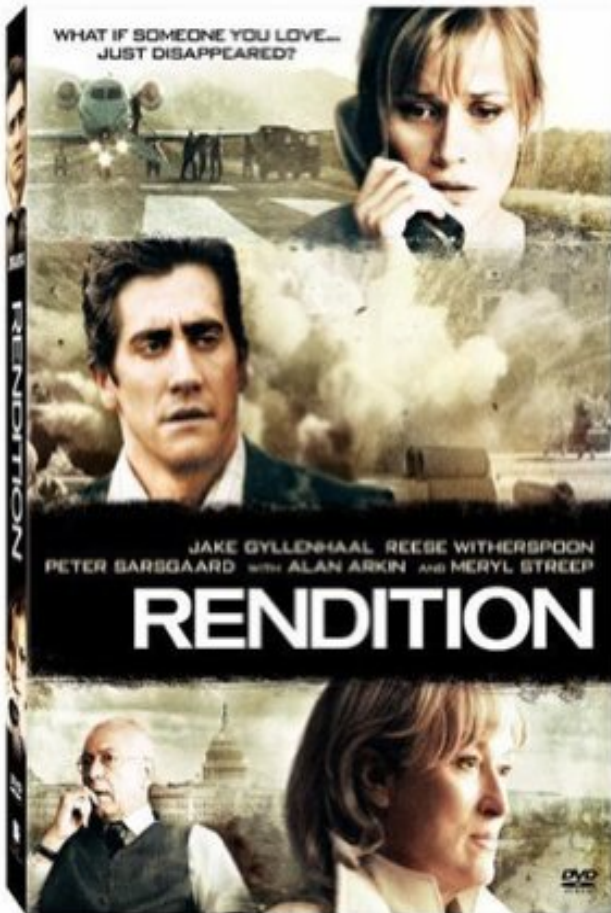


# “RENDITION” WHAT IF SOMEONE YOU LOVE...JUST DISAPPEARED?



When an Egyptian terrorism suspect "disappears" on a flight from Africa to Washington DC, his American wife and a CIA analyst find themselves caught up in a struggle to secure his release from a secret detention facility somewhere outside the US.

“RENDITION”. dramatizes the practice of kidnapping people who are suspected for any reason, or no good reason, of being terrorists. They are snatched from their lives and transported to another country to be held without charge and tortured for information. This practice, known as "**extraordinary rendition**," was authorized under the Clinton administration. After 9/11, there is reason to believe the Bush administration uses it.
