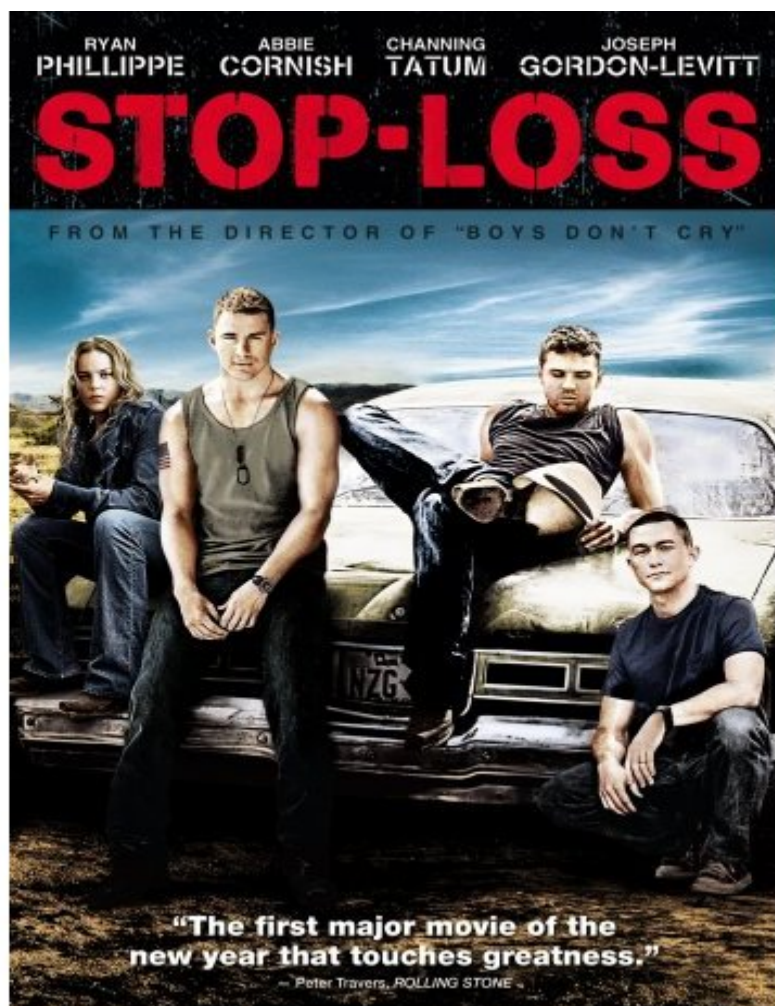


"STOP - LOSS" WHAT HAPPENS TO A SOLDIER WHEN HE IS ORDERED BACK TO IRAQ ?
