Israelis gets 83% of water from aquifers in the occupied West Bank, West Bank Palestinians get what's left.

Israel's overpumping of the coastal aquifer, its closures and its military attacks on infrastructure limit Palestinian access to water in the Gaza Strip.

80,000 Palestinian citizens of Israel have no running water or sewage systems.
