The Baptist Joint Committee has been supporting the separation of church and state since 1936. As the only national faith-based group solely focused on protecting religious freedom for all, it files briefs in pivotal Supreme Court cases, advocates for and against legislation, testifies in Congress and unites with others across faiths to ensure that every American has — and always will have — the right to follow his or her spiritual beliefs. This webinar is an exploration of how we are identifying and responding to the dangers of Christian nationalism in the wake of the January 6th insurrection. The panelists are The Most Rev. Michael Curry, Presiding Bishop and Primate of The Episcopal Church; The Rev. Elizabeth A. Eaton, Presiding Bishop of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America; and Dr. Andrew L. Whitehead, Associate Professor of Sociology at Indiana University Purdue University-Indianapolis.



Rev. Nancy Brink is a Trustee of Americans United for Separation of Church and State and the incoming chair of the National Governance Committee. She is the Director of the Office of Church Relations at Chapman University which provides spiritual support and leadership development on campus.
